The PAL card offers proof that employees have been trained to work at height safely.

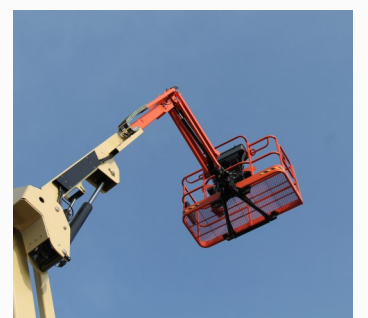
What makes IPAF the number one Power Access Training Scheme?

What is a PAL card?

A PAL card is a Power Access License, issued by the International Powered Access Federation, a non-profit making organisation dedicated to promoting safe working at height. Height workers need to show that they have been trained to work at height. If they can't they won't be allowed on site. That's why the PAL card is so important - it confirms that someone can operate mobile elevating work platforms safely and effectively.

IPAF has revised the categories in it's training programme to align with the international standards that regulate the design and manufacture of access platforms worldwide.

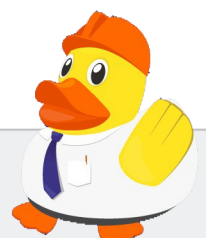

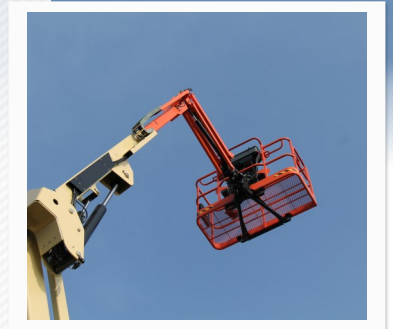
Aims
