

PASMA Training

Overview

PASMA stands for Prefabricated Access Suppliers and Manufacturers Association.

Whether you are an individual or a large company, the Working at Height regulations impact upon your work procedures and methods whilst at work.

All operatives working at height must be competent, which includes an understanding of the equipment they are using to work at height.

The PASMA Standard Operator's Course is designed to instruct up to a maximum of 12 delegates at a time.

Who should attend?

Anyone in your organisation who assemble, alter, dismantle, move, inspect and most importantly USE alloy or fibreglass mobile access towers in the workplace.

This not only includes construction sites but all work places, such as schools, offices and factories both internally and externally.

Course Content

Delegates are required to bring the following to courses:

- Full personal protective equipment, including hard hat, high visibility vest or jacket, tow protective boots and gloves and weather protective clothing (i.e. fleeces, waterproofs & windproofs etc.)
- National insurance Number
- Two passport sized photographs

On course completion, successful candidates are issued with a PASMA training Identity Card and certificate as personal proof of competency.

Certification is normally valid for a period of 5 years, unless otherwise stated, and re-certification can be achieved through our refresher course.
